Meeting Minutes March 22: 15 attended

Board Meeting update from March 15 meeting: The Rotary Club bank accounts have not been updated in many years, so we need to get the signers current. We will be accepting applications for the scholarship program and will be looking for a committee. We will start again with Student of the Month in September. The club voted to pay for the entire oven. A check will be presented to Lisa Martin at our next meeting, when she will be our speaker. This is a surprise to her.
