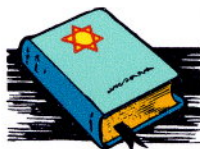

### Student of the Month— February

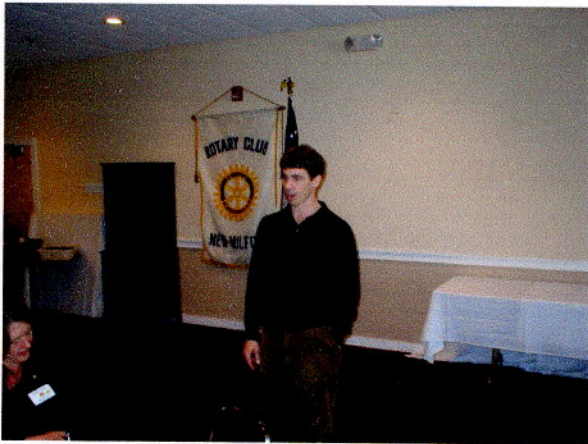
